Our annual HOA meeting was held on Saturday, November 6th with Kathy Velte- Lee going over the following:

Our dues will remain the same for the year 2022 however it is anticipated that they will increase in the future to keep up with inflation.

Road Maintenance Update:

Gravel added to corners to prevent road collapse and to protect that gravel, boulders were added. However, since boulders were not well received, 13 split rail fences were put at corners with more to follow. In about 6 month's time, those rail fences will be varnished so the wood will be protected. The remaining split rail fences will be installed in the near future.

Looking forward the roads will need in excess of a million dollars for maintenance and upkeep. The board is reviewing ways to generate these funds while avoiding a large future assessment. One option is to place some funds into an investment with potential for a greater return.

Safety Committee Update:

A new board member, Paul Minch, was elected. He will be specifically interested in the Safety and Security of our community. Greg Sanchez, our outgoing member, will still be active as Chair of our Architectural Committee. He will serve alongside another board member.
